Colleagues and partners are responsible for these, and you will be working closely with them. You will switch between German and English in your day-to-day business activities.
- You will keep yourself informed on the activities of (angel) investors as well as special seed funding from public authorities, and also assist startups with the compilation of documentation.
- You will be involved in all activities of the ESA BIC, particularly marketing activities, both domestically and internationally. In addition, you will assist with the organization of the annual Space Competitions, such as Galileo Masters and Copernicus Masters, for which you will also be taking over administrative tasks.
